This helmet is designed to protect impact caused by collision of head with an obstacle while doing cycling. It has passed EN 1078:2012+A1:2012 to show conformity to the EHSR of Regulation (EU) 2016/425.



USE

This helmet is recommended as protective equipment for the following activities (fig.A)



This helmet is not suitable for the activities indicated in red(fig B).

WARNING: No helmet can guarantee protection against all possible types of impact. There is always a risk of serious injury or death. Even a low-speed accident can cause serious injury or death. To be effective, this helmet must fit properly. There is no absolute guarantee of safety. This helmet is not suitable for children 12 years of age and under.



WARNING :

Children should not use this helmet for climbing or other hanging hazards (in case they get caught in the helmet).

To reduce the risk of strangulation or suffocation, this helmet should not be used by children during climbing exercises or other activities in which they may be pinched by others objects.

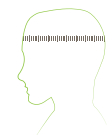
WARNING: Impact damage may be invisible to the user's eyes. In the event of impact, the helmet must be returned to the manufacturer for inspection or destroyed and replaced. Any alteration or removal of any of the original components of the helmet will result in hazards and reduce its protection. Even minor alterations will void the EKOI warranty and may reduce the level of protection provided by this helmet.

WARNING: Solvents, paints and adhesives can damage the helmet invisibly. Do not use the helmet if it has been exposed to any of these products. High temperatures (above 115°F / 45°C) can damage the helmet. Do not store your helmet in your car or near a heat source. Do not use the helmet if the shell has been deformed or melted. EKOI does not warrant helmets damaged by heat. This helmet is not suitable for use in a motor vehicle. If you are unable to adjust your helmet to fit your head properly, do not use it and contact our customer service.



WEARING THE HELMET

To protect you in case of impact, your helmet must be well adjusted (fig C). All EKOI helmets are available in a wide range of sizes; Try different sizes and choose the size that is best adapted to your morphology. The size of your head is not related to your age, therefore make sure you choose a helmet that is perfectly adapted to your head and avoid those that are too large or too small.

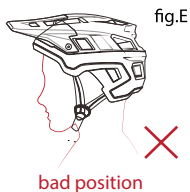
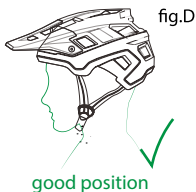
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HOW TO ADJUST YOUR HELMET

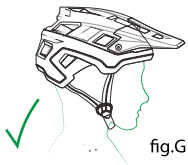
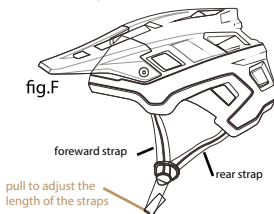
1 - Position your helmet correctly

Always wear your helmet so that the front is positioned to protect your forehead properly (fig.D). Never wear the helmet towards the rear to avoid exposing your forehead (fig.E).



2 - Adjusting the straps

To adjust the straps: Open the buckle (fig.F) Slide the straps in the lateral tightening clamp until you obtain the correct position (fig.G) Make sure that the straps are well tightened. Close and lock the lateral tightening clamp. Make sure that the straps do not cover your ears.





3 - Adjusting the chinstrap

When wearing the helmet, always make sure that the chinstrap buckle is properly closed (fig.H) and that the strap is tight. Make sure that the strap rests snugly on the inside of your chin, not towards the tip (fig.I) The excess strap should be held in place with the rubber ring (fig.J).

4 - Adjustment of the occipital support system.

Turn the knob clockwise to obtain comfortable support. To loosen, rotate the dial anti-clockwise (fig.K)

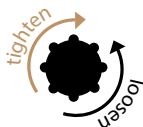

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5 - Tightening and adjustment

Before using the helmet, make sure that it is correctly positioned on your skull, that the straps are properly adjusted and that the chinstrap is tight enough. Install the helmet in the correct position for optimal use (see instruction No. 1). Block the chinstrap and tighten it snugly. Look at yourself in a mirror. > Check the adjustment. Grasp the helmet with both hands and try to turn it to the right and to the left. If the helmet is correctly adjusted, it will resist. If this is not the case, it is not tight enough. Check the straps. Grasp the helmet with both hands and try to remove it by tilting it as far as possible to the front and to the rear. If you can tilt it so that it interferes with your field of vision (toward the front) or if it exposes your forehead (toward the rear), it is not properly adjusted (fig.D).

CLEANING THE HELMET

Clean the helmet using only soap and water.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

To ensure correct use of your new EKOI helmet, please take the time to familiarise yourself with its design and features, its cleaning and maintenance and its usage conditions by reading the instructions (supplied with the helmet) prior to wearing it. The helmet's lifespan cannot be determined in advance. It depends on how it is used and maintained, environmental factors and accidental damage.



If any kind of accident occurs, the helmet should be replaced immediately.

If it has been subject to impacts or shows any other signs of wear or damage, the protection it offers cannot be guaranteed in case of accident.

Inspect the helmet prior to each use.

Do not expose the helmet to temperatures exceeding 50°C (do not leave inside a vehicle exposed to strong sunlight, etc.).

Under normal usage conditions (approximately 6,000 miles per year), we recommend replacing your helmet every two years.

TWO-YEAR GUARANTEE

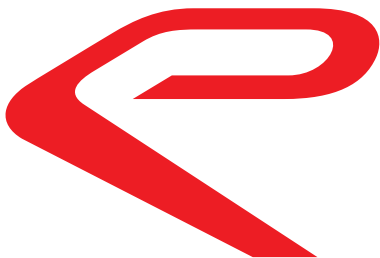
The EKOÏ EKOÏ AR14 helmet is guaranteed against all defects for two years, except where dropped/involved in a fall and in cases of ordinary wear and tear resulting from normal use and storage (see above).

The guarantee applies only to the initial purchaser of the helmet (it does not apply if the helmet is being used by or has been passed on to another person).

Instructions for use and care

- No helmet can protect the wearer against all possible impacts.
- The helmet is designed to be retained by a strap under the lower jaw.
- To be effective, a helmet must fit and be worn correctly. To check for correct fit, place helmet on head and make any adjustments indicated. Securely fasten retention system. Grasp the helmet and try to rotate it to the front and rear. A correctly fitted helmet should be comfortable and should not move forward to obscure vision or rearward to expose the forehead.
- For helmets designed to be fitted with an optional attachment, a statement of the types of attachment.
- For helmets not designed to be fitted with an attachment, no attachments should be secured to the helmet.
- The helmet is designed to absorb shock by partial destruction of the shell and liner. This damage may not be visible. Therefore, if subjected to a severe blow, the helmet should be destroyed and replaced even if it appears undamaged.
- The helmet may be damaged and rendered ineffective by petroleum and petroleum products, cleaning agents, paints, adhesives and the like, without the damage being visible to the user.
- A helmet has a limited lifespan in use and should be replaced when it shows obvious signs of wear.
- This helmet should not be used by children while climbing or doing other activities where there is a risk of hanging or strangulation if the child gets trapped while wearing the helmet.
